

Pro-Am 2-Way Canopy Formation Rules Official Test Event

GENERAL

The Pro-Am Canopy Formation (CF) event is intended to introduce new CF participants to national competition.

EVENT DESCRIPTION

Pro-Am 2-Way Sequential: Each round consists of five formations from two sets of the six formations as shown in the dive pool.

TEAM COMPOSITION

A pro-am 2-way team consists of up to four members, including the team videographer, but is eliminated from competition if for any reason it is cut to two or fewer members including the videographer. The team also either receives a zero for the round or is eliminated from competition if for any reason the two performing the designated dive do not meet the requirements for pro-am. The two members performing the designated dive must consist of either one “pro” and one “am” (1 pro/1 am) OR two (2) “ams.”

NUMBER OF ROUNDS

The minimum number of rounds to constitute a meet is one and the maximum (scheduled) number is five for the test event.

DEFINITIONS

PRO – An experienced canopy formation team member who has previously earned a world record OR a medal at a Nationals or Internationally sanctioned competition.

AM – A canopy formation team member who has NOT previously earned either a world record OR a medal at a Nationals or Internationally sanctioned competition.

PREVIOUSLY EARNED – A medal is considered “previous” when earned prior to the start of the current Nationals. Medals earned during the current Nationals are not considered “previously earned.”

FOR FURTHER RULES

All additional SCM rules applicable to CF 2-Way Sequential are incorporated and made applicable to this test event.
