MINUTES OF THE GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING
Fredericksburg, Virginia, July 11, 2003

1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by President Glenn Bangs at 7:01 P.M. The President inquired and it was determined by the Secretary that a quorum was not present in person or by proxy. There were 44 members in attendance and 1396 proxies.

2. Adjournment

A motion was presented by Vice President Mike Perry to adjourn, which was seconded and passed unanimously (**Motion #1**). The meeting was officially adjourned at 7:01 P.M.

Mr. Bangs informed the gallery of the rules regarding a quorum of 10% of the membership for conducting business at the General Membership Meeting. The Board of Directors and staff present conducted an informal open discussion session with the members in the gallery in attendance.

Member Don Jardine questioned changes to the candidate statements. This was addressed by former and current Nomination and Election Committee Chairmen.

There was a discussion of possible options, such as the PIA Symposium, for the General Membership Meeting to involve more members.

Chris Needels reviewed the status of the new headquarters relocation. National Director Scott Smith suggested the possibility of a sign at the site to indicate "Future Home of USPA & Museum of Skydiving."
