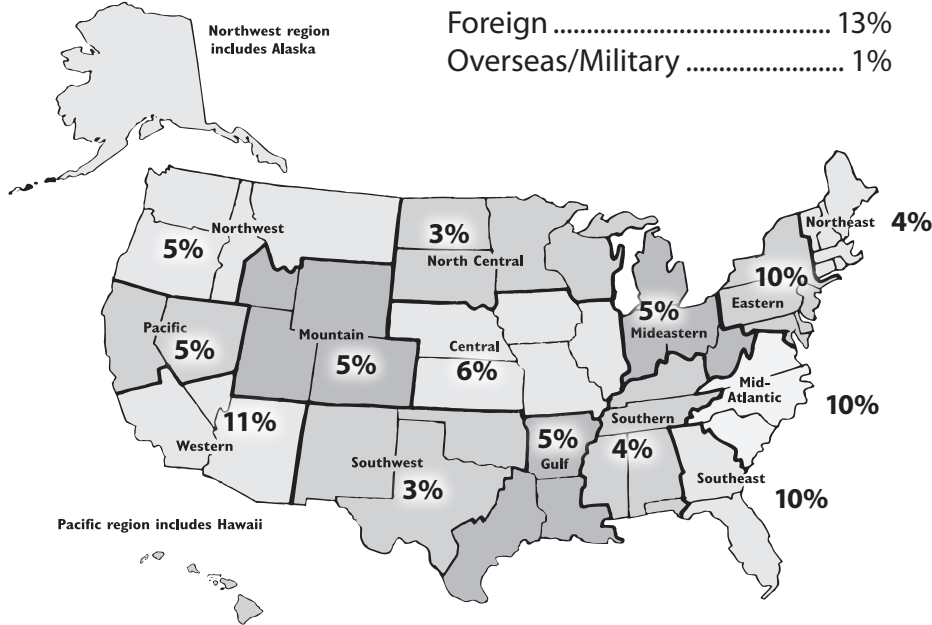


# 2010 Skydiving Review

## Reserve deployments

A total of 4,056 USPA members reported having to use their reserve parachutes a total of 5,309 times in 2010 (Note: Most reserve rides could have been avoided with proper gear maintenance and packing procedures.)

### Injuries

Current USPA members reported making a total of 3 million jumps in 2010. Out of those jumps, 1,308 people reported having a total number of 1,368 injuries. (Note: many minor injuries go unreported.)
